



Giving to NCLR through the CFC: Frequently Asked Questions

What is NCLR's agency number in the CFC?

Our number is 11318.

What is NCLR's federal tax identification number (also known as EIN)?

94-3086885

Is NCLR a non-profit organization?

Yes. NCLR is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation.

Is my gift tax-deductible?

Gifts to NCLR are tax-deductible to the full extent of the law.

How/when does NCLR receive my gift?

We typically receive your gift four to five months after your Campaign ends.

Does the CFC tell NCLR how much I gave?

No. Government regulations prevent the CFC from telling NCLR the amount of any donor's gift. We receive the total amount from your Campaign minus some administrative processing fees. Please let NCLR know how much you have pledged so that we may acknowledge and thank you appropriately.

Does the Campaign give NCLR my name and contact information (address and/or email)?

No. NCLR does not receive your name and contact information. If you would like to receive the full benefits of your NCLR membership – including newsletters, email updates, event invitations, and much more – please provide us with this information directly. In addition, we want to be able to acknowledge and thank you appropriately.
