



Giving to NCLR through the United Way: Frequently Asked Questions

To donate to NCLR through your workplace United Way campaign, first look for “National Center for Lesbian Rights” in the list of charities provided by your United Way Campaign. (Do not use our acronym, “NCLR.”) If you do not find us listed, you may be able to write us in on your pledge card. Just ask your Campaign Leader.

What is NCLR’s agency number?

Every United Way Campaign in which we participate assigns us a different number, which NCLR does not have. To find our number at your workplace, please read your Campaign materials or ask your Campaign leadership.

What is NCLR’s federal tax identification number (also known as EIN)?

Is NCLR a non-profit organization?

Yes. NCLR is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation.

Is my gift tax-deductible?

Gifts to NCLR are tax-deductible to the full extent of the law.

How/when does NCLR receive my gift?

Each Campaign runs a bit differently. We typically receive your gift beginning three to six months after your Campaign ends. If you chose to have a specified amount taken from every pay period, we receive payments in several installments.

Does the United Way tell NCLR how much I gave and/or my name and contact information (address and/or email)?

Sometimes, but not always. We receive the total amount from your Campaign minus some administrative processing fees. To ensure you are properly acknowledged and thanked for your gift – and to receive all the benefits of your NCLR membership, including newsletters, email updates, event invitations, and much more – please let NCLR know how much you have pledged and your full contact information as soon as you have made your United Way pledge.
